The fire limit is set at a special town council held Tuesday night. The fire limit is set at Block 25 and 42, all lots on street in Block 49, lots facing on Main street in Block 25, 42, 50 and half of Block 42, lots 15, 20 to 28 on block 51, lots 1 to 8, 20 to 23 on block 49, inclusive. All blocks are shown on plan of a water site.

The bylaw provides that the fire limits on new buildings shall be built with masonry, i.e., stone or concrete, incombustible materials. pairs shall be made with incombustible material laid in mortar not an inch thick, that brick, iron, stone or plaster under any building, and that no wooden floor be allowed in a large kitchen of first or second class hotels.
