EARLY MESSAGES

MORNING MESSAGES FROM CENTRAL EUROPE.
BRUSSELS, Feb. 28.
 The news which the Central Powers are ready to conclude peace with Russia has been confirmed by King Ferdinand to Count Cernin, the Austro-Hungarian Foreign Minister, according to dispatches received by way of Berlin. The King asked for a short period in which to consider the news, which was granted.

MORAVIAN PRESS REPORTS REVERENT.
PRAHA, Feb. 28.
 A formal denial was issued today by the Moravian Press Bureau to the German official statement, in which it was announced that President Cernin, former Moravian Premier of the Conservative party, had indicated that King Ferdinand of Romania should relinquish the throne. President Cernin was a member of the anti-war party in Romania. He was one of those reported to have remained behind in Bucharest when members of the Government and other prominent Romanians left the capital upon the approval of the troops of the Central Powers during the invasion of Romania in 1914.

JAPAN MAY INTERFERE IN SIBERIA.
LONDON, Feb. 28.
 A speech made Sunday by Viscount Noton, and reports from Paris as to Japan's possible activities in view of the German advance into Russia, was given prominence by the morning newspapers. The Times says it understands that the statement of the Japanese Foreign Minister is regarded as a military matter, the question of policy being decided by the Government of the Entente and America. It is freely admitted in official circles this is a very grave question. Indeed a radical departure from the established rules of international law would be involved in the forcible entry into a neutral country and consideration must be given to the possible effect upon the Russian people of such a course in their relations to the present war. Already there has been some apprehension that great numbers of Russian soldiers rather than return to their farms and shops would voluntarily join the Central armies, and some evidence of foundation for this fear is found in Berlin dispatches announcing the entry into the German army of several regiments of Estonians. On the other hand the growing indication that Japan can't much longer be restrained from taking some action in Siberia is causing serious consideration of the Japanese invitation to the Entente and America.
