> The note circulation, which was about 70,000,000,000 at the close of 1920, therefore has almost dougled during the year. The amount of discounted Treasury bills in the Reichsbanks hands has more than doubled during the year, the government's unsecured indegtedness to the bank being more than 132,000,000,000 marks, compared with sixty billions at the close of 1920. The bank's holdings of the government's paper increased in the final year more than 15,000,-000,000 marks, part representing direct government borrowings for that period, the rest in treasury certificates, which private holders unloaded for the Reichsbank to raise cash for their own requirements. The total amount of this floating debt in the Reichsbank and private hands is approaching perilously near a quarter of a trillion marks, if such astronomical figures have any meaning to the reader. The precise amount will be revealed in a few days, when the treasury statement of receipts and expenditures will be published.


