SAN FRANCISCO RELIEF, London, May 12.—The Knights Tem-plar of England forwarded a thousand dollars today to the American Knights Templar relief fund of San Francisco. The contribution was unanimously voted at a meeting of the great priory, pre-sided over by Lord Euston. to examine into the frontier question, and the foreign office declined to be-lieve that Ambassador O'Connor had accepted any "conditional surrender."
