The extreme and persistently bitter taste of the bark in its natural state has been a great bar to its use in the fluid extract form. With a view of overcoming this disadvantage without sacrificing its valued laxative properties, experiments were undertaken, which resulted in the devising of this preparation in 1889. It produces its characteristic action without griping.
