SIR,—I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your Note No. 77 of June 7, 1937, concerning the renewal for a period of one year beginning July 1, 1937, of the agreement now in effect between our two Governments whereby military aircraft of either country are permitted, under certain conditions, fly over specified portions of the territory of the other, and have duly noted that the Canadian Government is agreeable to the proposed renewal.
