EXCELLENCY:

I have the honor to refer to your note of May 14, 1971 with attached Annex regarding a joint program in the field of experimental remote sensing from satellites and aircraft.

The proposed program meets with the approval of my Government and my Government concurs in your proposal that your note, together with the Annex thereto, which are authentic in English and French, and this reply shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments for cooperation in a joint program of experimental remote sensing from satellites and aircraft, to be effective on the date of this reply for a period of four years unless terminated earlier by either Government upon six months notice, or extended by mutual agreement of the two Governments.
