

Canada has been active in supporting peace in Africa. As chair of the UN Security Council's Angola Sanctions Committee in 1999-2000, Canada was pivotal in ending one of Africa's longest civil wars. Canadian special envoys remain actively engaged in the peace processes in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and in Sudan.

Peace and security remains one of the main elements of Canada's support for NEPAD. Through the Canada Fund for Africa, Canada has provided \$15 million for an innovative peace and security initiative in West Africa and an additional \$4 million to support peace and security institutions, including the African Union and the new Kofi Annan International Peacekeeping Training Centre in Accra, Ghana.
