## APPOINTMENT TO IDRC

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announced today the appointment of Dr. Janet Wardlaw as Chairman of the International Development Research Centre.

Dr. Wardlaw, who is Associate Vice-President, Academic, at the University of Guelph, has had a long and distinguished academic career at universities in both Canada and the United States. She has been a professor at the Universities of Toronto and Guelph and academic visitor at the Universities of California, Berkeley, and Michigan and the Pennsylvania State University. From 1969-83, she was Dean of the College of Family and Consumer Studies at the University of Guelph. Dr. Wardlaw has also had extensive experience with organizations involved in international development, including the Canadian International Development Agency, the World Health Organization, the UN Food and Agriculture Organization and WUSC.
