do not have second thoughts about it in view of what the NDP Members are trying to do to them.

Perhaps I am giving the impression that I defend the position of the Progressive Conservative Members because they showed up in strength for the vote on the motion to adjourn the House and because of their attitude with respect to Standing Order 81 when they refused to agree with us, but I am not always in agreement with their tactics. God knows that more often than not I do not see eye to eye with them, but I do believe that it is a step in the right direction and in keeping with democracy. Parliament is a place where Members speak out against a measure, where they debate, argue and discuss, not a place where they prevent other Members from speaking by keeping the bells ringing or by blocking passage of legislation by delaying tactics which prevent Members on both sides of the House from taking part in the debates. In our democratic system, in a free society such as ours, we have the right to disagree on certain measures, but the way to voice our opposition under our rules and our practices, and in keeping with our traditions and our culture is not to prevent others from speaking by calling for recorded votes. It is simply by expressing our views in the House, conducting debates in accordance with the rules and accepting the point of view of a government which does hold the majority.
