**\*Question No. 98—Ms. Langan (Mission-Coquitlam):**

Did any Minister of the Crown sign an Order in Council dated May 7, 1991, proclaiming in force the amendments to the Parliament of Canada Act and, if so, which ministers?

**Mr. Albert Cooper (Parliamentary Secretary to Minister of State and Leader of the Government in the House of Commons):** Time required to prepare this answer: 3 hours

Approximate cost: \$54.

Order in Council P.C. 1991-813 dated May 7, 1991 brought amendments to the *Parliament of Canada Act* into force.

Ministers of the Crown must be in agreement in order for an Order in Council to be issued. As in the case of any other decision of the Cabinet, the names of the individual Ministers who participated in a particular decision are not released.

**\*Question No. 35—Mr. Gauthier:**

1. (a) For each of the last ten fiscal years, what was the annual rate of interest that the actuarial valuations of the basic pension accounts applying to members of the civilian public service, the Armed Forces, and the RCMP assumed would be earned by these accounts (b) what was the actual annual rate of interest earned by these accounts (c) by what dollar amount did the artificially low interest rate assumptions underestimate actual interest earnings of these accounts (d) what was the annual rate of salary revision increases that the actuarial valuations of these accounts assumed would be gained by contributors to these accounts (e) what was the actual annual rate of salary revision increases gained by contributors to these accounts (f) by what dollar amount did the salary revision increase assumptions exaggerate the actuarial liabilities of these accounts?
