

THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA.

BILL 26.

An Act respecting Radiotelegraphy.

(Reprinted as amended and reported by the Special Committee to which it was referred.)

HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as *The Radiotelegraph Act*. Short title.
- 5 2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,— Definitions.
(a) "Minister" means the Minister of the Naval Service; "Minister."
(b) "radiotelegraph" includes any wireless system for "Radio-telegraph."
conveying electric signals or messages including radio-
telephones;
- 10 (c) "coast station" means any radiotelegraph station "Coast station."
which is established on land or on board a ship permanently
moored and which is used for the exchange of messages and
electric signals with ships at sea;
- 15 (d) "land station" means any radiotelegraph station "Land station."
or installation of radiotelegraphic apparatus which is not
a coast station or a ship station;
- (e) "ship station" means any radiotelegraph station "Ship station."
established on board a ship which is not permanently
moored.
- 20 3. No person shall establish any radiotelegraph station Radio-telegraph stations and apparatus to be licensed.
or install or work any radiotelegraph apparatus in any place
in Canada or on board any ship registered in Canada except
under and in accordance with a license granted in that
behalf by the Minister.
