An Act respecting Radiotelegraphy.

IS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as The Radiotelegraph Act.

Short title.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,— Definitions. (a) "Minister" means the Minister of the Naval Service; "Minister." (b) "radiotelegraph" includes any wireless system for "Radio-conveying electric signals or messages including radio-telegraph."

(c) "coast station" means any radiotelegraph station "Coast which is established on land or on board a ship permanently station." 10 moored and which is used for the exchange of messages and electric signals with ships at sea;

(d) "land station" means any radiotelegraph station "Land 15 or installation of radiotelegraphic apparatus which is not station." a coast station or a ship station;

(e) "ship station" means any radiotelegraph station "Ship established on board a ship which is not permanently station." moored.

No person shall establish any radiotelegraph station Radio-20 or install or work any radiotelegraph apparatus in any place telegraph stations and in Canada or on board any ship registered in Canada except apparatus to under and in accordance with a license granted in that be licensed. behalf by the Minister.
