

THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL S-14.

An Act to incorporate the Congregation of the Sisters of the Holy Family of Bordeaux.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Congrégation des Soeurs de la Sainte-Famille au Canada, hereinafter called "the Congregation", is a religious congregation in communion with the Roman Catholic Church; and whereas the persons hereinafter named have by their petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Incorporation.

1. Cécile Gonthier (known in the Congregation as Reverend Mother Marie-Delphine), Charlotte Aubin (known in the Congregation as Reverend Mother Saint-Jean-Evangéliste), both of the city of Montreal, Alice Leclerc (known in the Congregation as Reverend Mother Marie-de-Gonzague), of the city of Quebec, Maria Chouinard (known in the Congregation as Reverend Mother Marie-de-la-Croix), of Montreal, Carmen Normand (known in the Congregation as Reverend Mother Marie-Julie), of St. Paul l'Ermite, in the county of L'Assomption, and Murielle Laurin (known in the Congregation as Reverend Mother Marie-de-Lorette), of the city of St. Laurent, all in the province of Quebec, and all who are or who may become members of the Congregation, are hereby incorporated under the name of the Congregation of the Sisters of the Holy Family of Bordeaux, and in French, Congrégation des Soeurs de la Sainte-Famille de Bordeaux, hereinafter called "the Corporation".

Provisional directors.

2. The persons named in section 1 of this Act shall be the first directors of the Corporation and shall constitute the first Board of Directors of the Corporation.
