CHAP. 190.

An Act respecting the Royal Canadian Academy of Arts.

[Assented to 6th June, 1913.]

HEREAS a society consisting of professional artists preamble. was founded in Canad in the year 1880, by Ifis Excellency the Marqu of Lorne, then Governor General of Canada and Her Royal Highness Princess Louise, and with the sanction of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, under the name of the "Royal Canadian Academy of Arts"; and whereas the said society obtain an Act of incorporation from the Parliament of Canada - Ethled "An Act to incorporate the Royal Canadian Academy of Arts," being chapter 122 of the statutes of 1882; and whereas the 1882, c. 122. said Royal Canadian Academy of Arts has by its petition prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:---

1. This Act may be cited as The Charter of the Royal short title. Canadian Academy of Arts.

2. The present academicians and associates, members of incorporation the said Royal Canadian Academy of Arts, and such other continued.
