THE SUPPLY OF COTTON

There was great excitement on the
New York and New Orleans market
when it was reported that the cotton
crop was only 6,000,000 bales. Last year
it was 10,700,000 bales, and four years
ago it was 12,250,000. In New York

hiding, and prices jumped sixty or
seventy points before the advance

MONEY IN SHEEP RAISING

That sheep raising on a large scale
can be made profitable in Canada is
shown by the bulletin recently issued by
the Department of Agriculture at Ot-
tawa. Canada can provide immense
areas of pastures in summer and rape
and turnips, according to the depart-
ment report, make excellent food for
cattle and sheep. When clover hay and
alfalfa are not available other suitable
roughage can be found. Oats and bran
are convenient grain feeds, while peas
and beans are also widely available.

ON EVE OF ELECTIONS

North Renfrew is a fickle riding. It
changes from one political party to an-
other with remarkable regularity, and
thus the politicians always consider it
a "swing" riding. Since Confederation
there have been fourteen elections for
the provincial legislature, and in these
eight Liberal and six Conservative
were successful. Four of these were
won over to the other column. So that
if North Renfrew be true to its tradi-
tions, E. A. Dunlop will win in the
by-election of Dec. 26. The by-
election of 1890 resulted in the return
of Thomas Murray, Liberal, in suc-
cession to John Supply, Conservative,
who resigned. In 1892 Mr. Murray
resigned to run for the House of Com-
mons, and was succeeded by a Conser-
vative, W. B. McAllister, who was
elected by acclamation. He, however,
resigned to become a member of the
by-election was in 1892, after the
death of A. Dunlop, father of the pres-
ent Conservative candidate, and a Lib-
eral, H. Barr was returned. The death
of A. Dunlop, without a member, and
the late J. W. Munro, Liberal, was
given the seat by acclamation. In the
elections for the House of Commons, North
Renfrew has been on both sides, the seat being
held six times by Conservatives and
three times by a Liberal. Peter White
was elected five successive times, and
the present member, Thomas Mackie,
Liberal, has held the seat for two
terms.
