A STATELY WELCOME TO THE CZAR AT COWES

Britain, Officially, Is Very Pleased To Have Nicholas as a Guest of Honor.

MIGHTY FLEET REVIEWED MONARCHS TALK PEACE

COWES, Aug. 2.—The Russian imperial yacht Standart, bringing the emperor and the empress from Cherbourg to Cowes, on a visit to King Edward, anchored in the Cowes roadstead shortly before 1 o'clock to-day. Their majesties were given an official welcome even more imposing than usually attends such occasions. Not only were King Edward and Queen Alexandra, the prince and Princess of Wales and a large gathering of other members of the royal family present to greet their guests, but 150 of the pick of the British war fleet, dressed in flags from stem to stern and flying the Russian ensign, encircled the anchorage allotted to the Standart.

SAFEGUARDING THE CZAR

EXPRESSIONS OF FRIENDSHIP

The dinner was a brilliant function. The dining room was beautifully decorated with red roses, and on the table was a magnificent display of gold plate. Beside the King and Queen and the emperor and empress, the guests were the crown prince and crown princess of Sweden, the Prince and Princess of Wales, the Duke and Duchess of Connaught, Premier Asquith, Sir Edward Grey, Reginald McKenna and M. Tsvolovsky.

Public in Background

The unusual welcome of this morning was arranged designedly for the double purpose of helping to strengthen the links in the chain binding Great Britain, France and Russia in a triple entente, and to dissipate any ill-feeling engendered by the denials of Emperor Nicholas and his methods, so frequently vented by the members of the Labor party both in and out of parliament since the coming of the emperor was first announced.

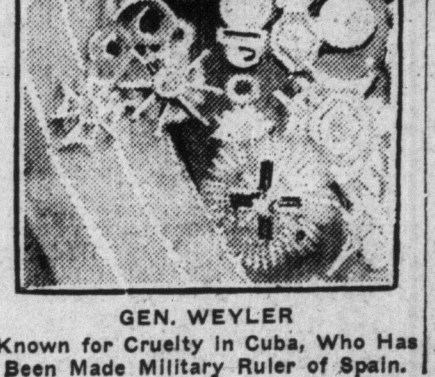

RECIPIENCY IN IMPLEMENTS AND COAL

PETAWAWA CAMP, Aug. 2.—(Special).—From the aviators' standpoint, the feature of the preliminary trials of the "Silver Dart" over Petawawa common early to-day was the successful working of the new motor.

Four flights, or hops, were made, the first three being about a half mile each and the fourth about three-quarters of a mile.

Britain Adopts Dirigibles For the Army and Navy

LONDON, Aug. 2.—The sub-committee of the imperial defence committee, appointed to consider matters of aviation, has given a verdict in favor of rigid dirigible balloons for naval purposes and non-rigid balloons for the army.

The aeroplane committee considers that these machines possibly may become valuable to the army, but say they must be able to ascend to a much greater height than yet has been achieved before they will be safe for reconnoitering purposes.

War Secretary Haldane announced in the house of commons this afternoon that in consequence of this report the admiralty had ordered a rigid dirigible of the largest type from the Vickers, and that the government factory at Aldershot was busy with the construction of three non-rigid balloons and two aeroplanes for experimental purposes.

TACTICS FOR ACQUITTAL WERE AMUSING TO THAW

On Arrival at Asylum—Certain Incidents Were Exaggerated.

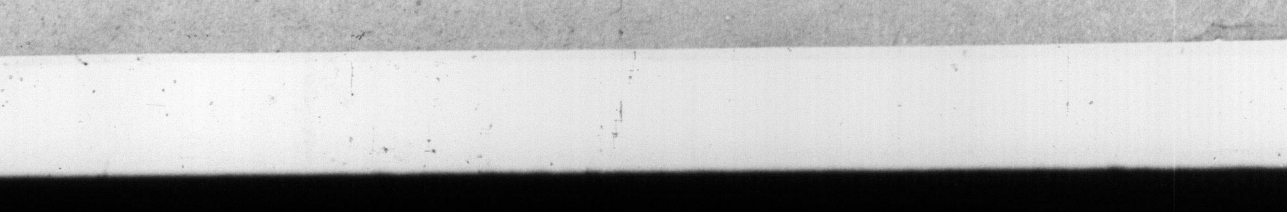
