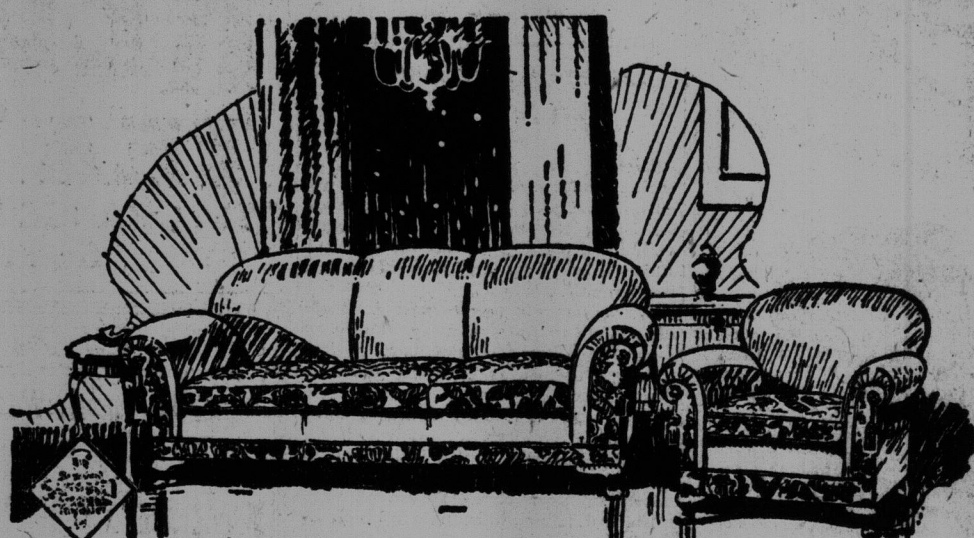
Robert Strayhorn.

Robert Strayhorn, 74 years of age, was stricken last evening while waiting in the West Side toll house for the ferry and died before medical aid could reach him. He was accompanied by his daughter, Mrs. Albert Laird, with whom he resided at 140 St. John street, and when they left home was apparently in his usual health. During the day he had been to Ketepec for a motor drive and was on his way to one of the entertainments in the city last evening.

Mrs. Laird noticed him put his head back and slump down into his seat. Dr. R. M. Fendrich was summoned but found that life was extinct. Dr. F. L. Kenney, coroner, decided that death was due to natural causes and no inquest was necessary.

Mr. Strayhorn was born and brought up in St. John but later moved to Point Wolfe, Albert county, where his wife died several years ago. He is survived by five sons, William, of Boston; James, with the C. N. R. in Moncton; John, of Alma, Albert county; Percy, of St. John, and Ira, of Boston; four daughters, Mrs. Haddow Sheldie, of Sussex; Mrs. William McManus, of Truro, N. S.; Miss Jessie Strayhorn, of Halifax, and Mrs. Albert Laird, with whom he lived; three brothers, Thomas, of St. John; Clark, of Boston, and William, of Centerville; and one sister, Mrs. James Bond, of St. John.

He had lived in West St. John for the last four years following his retirement from active labor. He was formerly

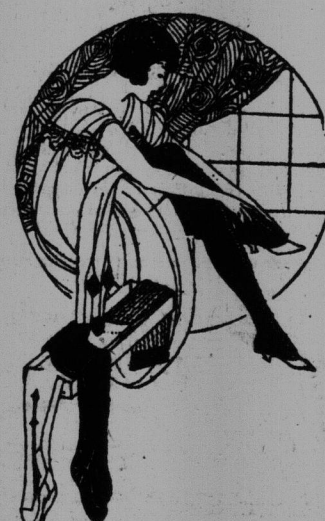
