CLEANER STREETS DRIVE BOOTBLACKS TO OTHER TRADES

London, Feb. 18.—(A. P. by mail.)—Cleaner streets are mainly responsible for the special disappearance of another of London's landmarks, the red-coated shoe blacks who formerly were stationed at prominent places in the city and west End.

Years ago these men, who numbered 2,000, made sufficient money in a few years to start business on their own account, but slackened demand for the shining of shoes has depleted their number to about 400, most of whom find it hard to make a bare living. This is due partly to men about towns being less careful of their appearance since the war; the fact that there is less money in people's pockets; and that the streets today are much cleaner as a result of asphalt paving on sidewalks and macadam in roadways.

MORNING NEWS OVER THE WIRES

The schooner Friendship, waterlogged and kept afloat during a long battle with heavy gales, was towed into Hampton Roads, Va., Saturday by the coastguard cutter Vape Henry. The crew were taken off safely.

The Sydney steel workers will resume work today following a large majority vote on Saturday afternoon to end the strike about 3,000 men which commenced on Tuesday when one of their number was discharged for alleged insubordination. An inquiry into the case has been promised.

The main estimates laid before the Federal House on Friday will be reduced half a million. When the Public Works estimates are considered in committee of supply the item of \$500,000 for a new departmental building in Ottawa will be withdrawn. It is the intention of the government to use \$500,000 asked for under a vote to put up a new printing bureau building for government work and utilize the present printing bureau building for departmental offices.

GIVES HIMSELF UP ADMITTING MURDER

Regina, Feb. 18.—"I have just murdered a man," was a statement made by Pete Bagatoff, a resident of Radisson district, after he had walked thirteen miles in Radisson to give himself up to the provincial police. Bagatoff declared that he had hit Andrew Kanyan, a farmer, over the head with an axe. The men are alleged to have engaged in a fight following an argument.

WOMAN EXPERT WINE-TASTER

London, Feb. 18.—(Canadian Press).—The City of London has a woman wine-taster—probably the only wine-taster of her sex in the wholesale business in this country. Mrs. J. M. Fisher is the person who occupies this unique position.

Mrs. Fisher's father, Maurice Meyer, who died some years ago, conducted an old established wholesale wine business at Roman Wall House, No. 1, Crutched Friars, London, and after his death his daughter took up the business and has since conducted it with remarkable success. She is the sole proprietress of the establishment.

"As far as I know," Mrs. Fisher told an interviewer recently, "I am the only woman wine-taster in the wholesale trade. Wine must be tasted in the morning before luncheon, and you must have a clean palate to begin with. It should not be done after smoking, or immediately after a meal."

Further explaining the wine-tasting as a professional, Mrs. Fisher said: "The wine should be taken on the tip of the tongue and conveyed to the roof of the mouth." Mrs. Fisher's palate is so sensitive that while blindfolded she can tell the difference between one brand of wine and another.

DANCE CRAZE IN BERLIN

Berlin, Feb. 18.—(A. P. by mail).—Berlin has too many dance halls and too few apartments, it was decided recently by the municipal authorities, and drastic measures were taken to bring about a change.

Certain of the most places of amusement have been ordered closed, and the rooms are to be made over into quarters where people may live. Since the dancing craze struck the German capital there has been a great demand for rooms of most any kind, particularly in the downtown districts. These were quickly furnished and advertised as dance halls with most pretentious names. In one instance a "dance hall" was brought into being in less than two days. The furnishings consisted chiefly of putting down some linoleum, hanging a few fancy trimmings from the ceiling, crowding tables and chairs into every available place, sticking the hands off into one corner, and then permitting the waiters to take charge. The crowd did the rest.

The craze reached such a stage recently that officials estimated that there had more places of entertainment and amusement than ever before in history. But the new order has put many of the smaller establishments out of business, and now where jazz music once had full sway after dark, there are entire families slumbering peacefully.
