- Q.99. Was that the only two rooms that the accused was responsible for?
- A.99. Well sir I don't quite remember whether he had another room at that time. I believe he had just the two, as far as I know.
- Q.100. Who was responsible for Colonel Chater's room at that time?
- A.100. L/Cpl. Ritchings.
- Q.101. Was he on duty that morning?
- A.101. He was sir.
- Q.102. Did you see Pte. Lilley in room 23 prior to the report of the wallet being lost?
- A.102. I didn't sir.

- Q.103. Prior to the report of the loss of the purse what part of the quarters were you in?
- A.103. I was down by the telephone booth there sir, looking after the linen at that time when the report was made.
- Q.104. How far is that from room 23?
- A.104. Roughly the length of this room I would say. (A distance of approximately 30-35 feet)
