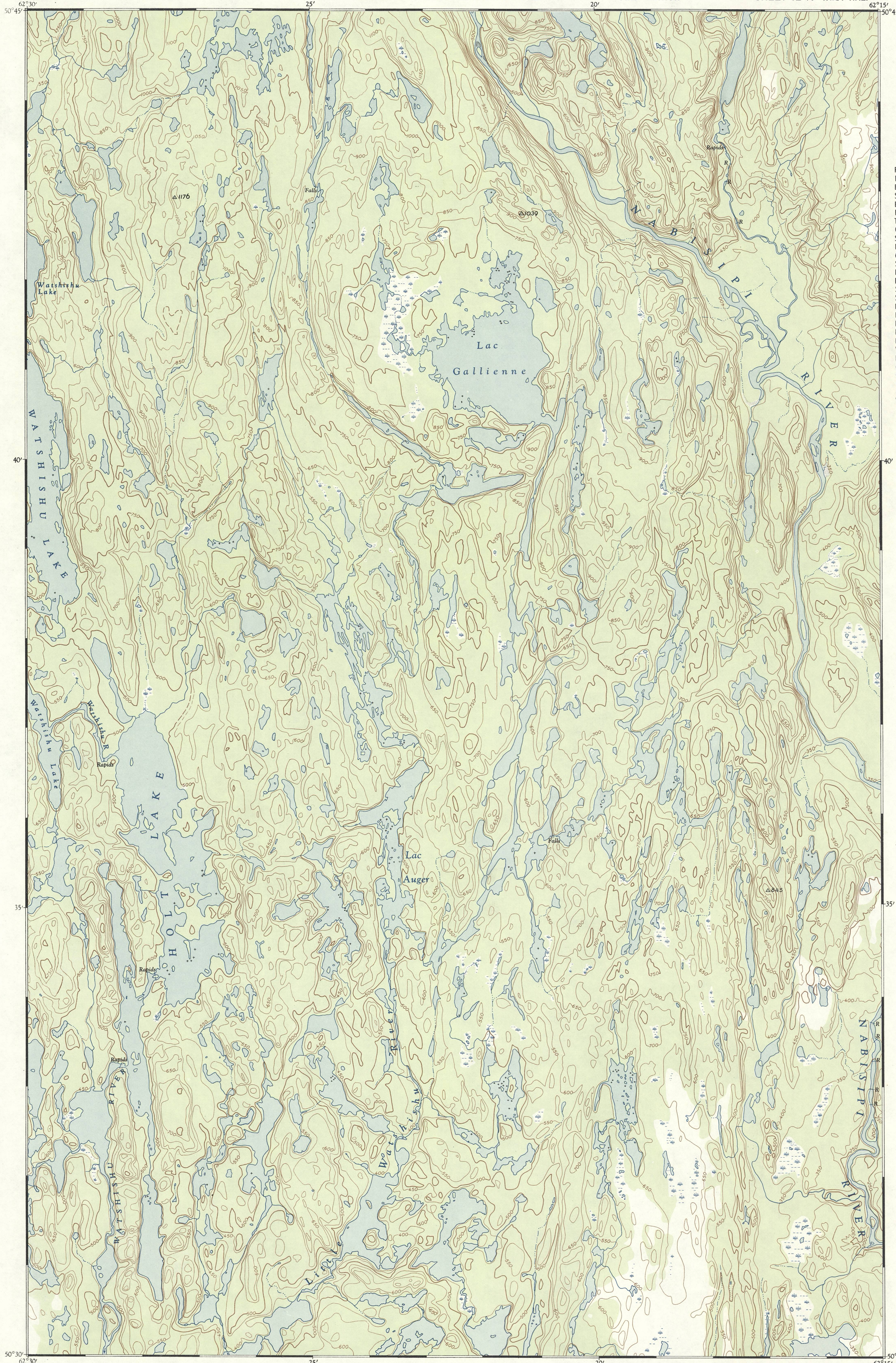


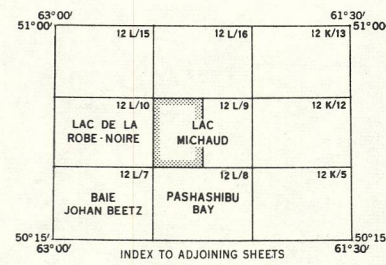

Annual magnetic change 3' easterly.

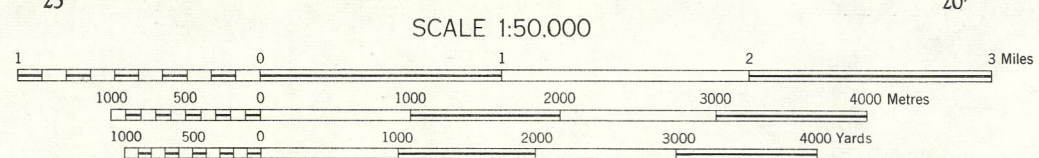
