Washington, Mar. 1—The depart-ment of labor today refersed to deport Count James Minotto, son-in-law of Louis Swift, the Chicago packer, on charges preferred by the directors of naval intelligence, but because of the suspicions aroused by his German birth and associations, dismissal of the arrest warrant was postponed un-til the department of justice decid-es whether the Count should be in-terned as an enemy allen. Pending action by the atorney-general, the Count will remain at lib-erty on \$50,000 bail, furnished by his father-in-law.
