

THE FULL POWER OF FRANCE

L *Evre* by the Grace of God King of *France* and *Navarr*, to all those to whom these present Letters shall come, Greeting: As we desire, nothing so earnestly as to behold the War, wherewith Christendom is afflicted to terminate in a firm and lasting Peace, and forasmuch as through the Care and Mediation of our Dearest and very well Beloved Brother the King of *Sweden*, the Cities of *Delft* and the *Hague*, have been agreed upon by all the Parties, for holding the Conferences necessary to this effect: We out of the same ardent desire to put a stop, as much as in us lyes, and by the assistance of Divine Providence to the Desolation, and Effusion of Christian Blood, give to understand that we intirely confiding in the experience, capacity, and fidelity of our well beloved and loyal Subject the *Sieur de Harlay de Boneuil*, ordinary Counsellour in our Council of State, and of our well beloved the *Sieur Verjus*, Count de *Crecy*, Baron de *Courvay*, Lord de *Boulay*, two Churches, *Ministers* and other places, as also in that of our well beloved the *Sieur de Callieres*, de la *Rochellay* and de *Gigy*, who is actually in the City of *Delft*, by reason of the repeated Tryals that we have made of the same in the several important Employes, wherewith
