An Act to vest in Edward Shortis, of Toronto, Esquire, the road or concession allowance between lots numbers fifteen and sixteen in the sixth concession of the Township of Thorah.

WHEREAS Edward Shortis, of Toronto, Esquire, has granted two Roads on and over Lots fifteen and sixteen in the sixth Concession of the Township of Thorah, and in consequence thereof the Road or Concession allowance between the said Lots is no longer required; and whereas the Municipality of the said Township of Thorah has adopted the said Roads, and consented that the said Road or Concession allowance should be vested in the said Edward Shortis, in lieu of the said Road so granted by him as aforesaid: Be it therefore enacted, &c. Preamble.

That for and notwithstanding any thing in any Act of the Parliaments of Upper Canada, or of Canada, contained, the Road or Concession allowance between Lots numbers fifteen and sixteen in the sixth Concession of the said Township of Thorah, shall be and is hereby vested in the said Edward Shortis, his heirs and assigns forever. The said allowances for road vested in E. Shortis, his heirs and assigns.

II. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
