## BILL.

An Act to amend the Act therein mentioned for the protection of Indians in Upper Canada, by repealing the third Section thereof.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act hereinafter mentioned by repealing the third Section thereof; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

That the third Section of the Act passed in the Session held in Sect. 3 of 13 the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and cap. 7.4 reintituled, "An Act for the protection of the Indians in Upper Canada realed. from imposition, and the property occupied by them from tresspass or injury," shall be, and the said Section is hereby repealed.

II. And be it enacted, That the time elapsed between the Acetain period not to coming into force of the Act hereinbefore cited and the coming be reckoned as into force of this Act, shall not be reckoned in computing the time regards the within which an action must be brought on any Bond, Bill, Note, Limitations. Provise or other Contract, or for the recovery of any debt referred to in the said Section of the said Act, in order to prevent its being 15 barred by the Statute of Limitations.
