

this section ; and no provision or enactment which the Legislature shall hereafter make for the purpose of compelling the performance of the provisions and conditions in this section contained, or for settling the terms and conditions upon which any other Company may connect their Railway with that herein authorized to be constructed, shall be deemed an infringement of the privileges granted by this Act.

LVI. And be it enacted, That the said Company to entitle themselves to the benefits and advantages to them granted by this Act, shall and they are hereby required to make and deposit the map or plan and book of reference mentioned in the fifth Section of this Act within one year after the passing thereof, and to make and complete the said Railway from the Niagara River to the Detroit River in manner aforesaid, within seven years from the passing of this Act : and if the said map or plan and book of reference be not so made and deposited within the said one year, or if the said Railway shall not be made and completed within the said period so as to be used by the public as aforesaid, then and in either case this Act and every matter and thing therein contained, shall cease and be utterly null and void.

Map and Book of reference to be deposited and the Railway to be completed within certain periods, or this Act to be void.

LVII. And be it enacted, That the said Company shall annually submit to the three Branches of the Legislature, within the first fifteen days after the opening of each Session of the Provincial Parliament, after the opening of the said Railway or any part thereof to the public, a detailed and particular account, attested upon oath, of the moneys by them received and expended under and by virtue of this Act, with a classified statement of the amount of tonnage and of passengers that have been conveyed along the said Railway ; And no further provisions which the Legislature may hereafter make with regard to the form or details of

Company annually to submit to the Legislature detailed accounts.

Further provision may be made touching such accounts.
