An Act for removing doubts as to the legal effect of the Act of the Legislature of Lower Canada, passed in the ninth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Fourth, and intituled, An Act for rendering valid conveyances of lands and other immovable property held in free and common soccage within the Province of Lower Canada, and for other purposes therein mentioned, and for the greater uniformity of the Law relative to real property in Lower Canada.

WHEREAS the Act passed by the Le- Preamble gislative Council and Assembly of the late Province of Lower Canada, in the ninth year of the Reign of His late Majesty o King George the Fourth, and intituled, An Act of L. C of Act for rendering valid conveyances of lands ched and other immovable property held in free and common soccage within the Province of Lower Canada, and for other purposes therein men-10 troned, was presented for the Royal Assent on the fourteenth day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine, and was then reserved by the Administrator of the Government of the 15 said Province for the signification of His Majesty's pleasure thereon; And whereas the said Act was assented to by His late Majesty, King William the Fourth, on the eleventh day of May, in the year of Our 20 Lord, one thousand eight hundred and thirtyone, and the Royal Assent thereto was sigmfied by proclamation in the said Province, on the first day of September, in the year last aforesaid, so that more than two years 25 had elapsed between the presentation of the said Act for the Royal Assent and the signification of the Royal Assent as a foresaid;
