A 14-year-old boy was wounded last week when a gun his 17year old brother, was cleaning in their Paisley Boulevard home accidentally discharged.

Lawrence Leggo, 17, was cleaning a .22 calibre rifle which he believed to contain a blank cartridge. When he inserted the gun's bolt it fired, sending several shell fragments into his brother's elbow. The brother was admitted to Mississium destination


