of erecting some buildings on the reserve, which would be available for Indians coming to the city from time to time, that is, provided the city does not make some provision for them, in the way of cheap buildings.

I had an interview with the Mayor today on this subject, and as he is anxious to retain the Indians as customers for the business men of the city, he promised to take the matter up with the Council, with a view of providing accommodation for them while in the city.

I have no hesitation in saying that the report made to the Council about the unsanitary condition of the Indian camp, was greatly exaggerated, and the Chief of Police, who is quite conversant with the affair, agrees with me, and he is rather at a loss to know why such a fuss was made about the matter.
