19. MONDAY. [171-194]
 Accession of Queen Victoria, 1837.

Rained some I took James for an interpreter we went all around the Beardsy house measured all his fields & fence & gave them rations. Beardsy would not let his men use the battle to break the I.S. and his men came here this evening. Old Jack Smith is still here. Gave 5 meals.

20. TUESDAY. [172-193]
 Proclamation of Queen Victoria.

Raining all day the I.A. did not get away until evening. So is no better. James could do nothing.
 Very Cold Rain

Gave 7 meals

21. WEDNESDAY. [173-192]

Raining all day could get nothing done. Beardsy sent the old men down to see if I would give them grub. Jack Smith left to day.

22. THURSDAY. [174-191]

Rained some I went over to one arrow and counted all his rails and measured all his land. That he sowed this year I took James with me for interpreter. He was working in the garden had a big sowwow with one arrow. Crowd James & me. Old Jack Smith came here to night.

23. FRIDAY. [175-190]
 St. John Baptist—Midsummer Day.

Fine day at last Jack Smith left this morning. The boys were having potatoes. I was working at the kitchen. Several Indians called to get grub. I could not see the point.
 Gave 3 meals

24. SATURDAY. [176-189]

Fine day James was helping me at the kitchen. Had 2 squaws washing bags. Several Indians came wanting grub.
 So left for Winnipeg

Gave 2 meals

25. SUNDAY. 3 after Trinity. [177-188]

A beautiful day the mail came in last night. I received a fine pony from the I.A. he is old horse spring and has the spring halt in the hind legs. I send my old man to him by order of the I.A.

26. MONDAY. [178-187]

Rather fine day I took morning grub down to the river. I then took some grub up to Beardsy and started to plow to break them. 3 or 4 Indians saw them that will not work. I went up again in the evening I took an interpreter but could get no satisfaction out of Beardsy.

27. TUESDAY. [179-186]

Fine day Had 4 Indians having potatoes and 2 squaws washing. I sent the I.S. at St. Roberts. He gave the two James was having with the Indians. He has to do the milking every day which takes a great part of his time. The cows are wild.

28. WEDNESDAY. [180-185]
 St. Peter & St. Paul.

Raining now all day. James was mending turnips we had 4 Indians and 3 squaws helping. I am tormented with Indians wanting grub.

29. THURSDAY. [181-184]

Fine day I went up to Beardsy. I gave two men that is plowing 3 days rations. I gave one ration to the green bottom potato. James was working in the garden.

Gave 2 meals

30. JULY—FRIDAY. [182-183]
 Long Vacation Begins—Dominion Day—Bank Holiday.

I took James for an interpreter and went over to the men and Beardsy. James measured what land they had broken this year. The I.A. sent one horse and 2 cows 2 year old heifers & 3 calves.

1. SATURDAY [183-182]

July Fine day I took 2 sacks of flour and 40 lb bacon down to Fisher. I was going over to one arrow but could not cross on account of high wind. James was mending in the garden.

2. SUNDAY. 3 after Trinity. [184-181]

Very fine day beautiful growing weather
