Some time ago for lieuxe to remove elm stave bollo to assist him in building Respecting the 2 m Resolution I have Juguetly represed my opinion that lienses for the removal of fire wood should be granted only to those who are clearing land for agricultural purposes and that the lieuxes should evvir a cortain number of acres and not a curtain number of cords The advantage of such a system to me are putent. If liences are granted for a certain number of cords, the party would have 1th to obtain a sort of primary license for doing so, 2 " a certificate that that the wood was cut and measured upon a proper part of the hot and 3 - a transe to remove it - and Them what sixurity have we that just that amount of wood was removed and that it was from the place specified The bailiffs would have to keep track of every load taken out which would be un posseble. Besides which if I deine to char say 5 acres of land
