The second payment appears to have been made at Ottarra by Him Carson. and the next by the auctioner, mi & f. Lale (since deceased) on behalf of Hun Carson; and the last payment was remitted to the Indian Office Toronto by My Carson in a letter dated April 1868. Me Clummer further reporta that he is informed that George, the eldest sow of Mrs Carson, does not appear to be a party to the document signed by the other knembers of the family consenting to the issue of Catent to their mother; and he has been given to understand that the Raid
