Ottawa, 30 December, 1909.

Sir,-

I re-enclose herewith the pay-lists which you submitted in connection with payments made to Indians of the Blackfoot Reserve for land recently surrendered by them. It is desired that you will make out the pay-lists so as to show the names of the Indians in the same order as they appear on the annuity pay-lists. You should also explain in the "Remarks Column" the reason why the Indians were not paid their respective shares of surrender money.

The following are a few of the numbers which appear on the annuity pay-lists but which have been left off the surrender ~~max~~ list of Hind Bull's Band, viz:- 29, 30, 47, 49, 66, 81, 87, 88, 81, 128 and 152. You

should see that the names and numbers of the members of this Band are correctly entered in the pay-list and also that correct entries are made of all Indians' names and numbers belonging to all other Bands included in the pay-lists.

I have to refer you to the Department's letter of the 4th instant, setting forth certain requirements regarding the pay-list, with which you have failed to comply.
