

Before, however, an appeal would be decided upon, it would be necessary that all the facts of each case should be clearly known to the Department. I have, therefore, to request that you will furnish a separate report on each case, detailing clearly the facts in respect to the same, with a view to the submission of each of the reports to the Department of Justice for an opinion as to the advisability of an appeal.
