Gentlemen:-

Replying to your communication of the 24th ultimo I have to advise that the S.W.1/4, Sec. 9, ^{West of Leech Lake,} the N. W.1/4, Sec. 3, and the N.E.1/4, Sec. 4, Tp. 24, Rge. 4, W-2-M, are entered in the name of Jadis Yaroschewski, and the S.E.1/4, Sec. 4, is entered to Wadeslaw Yaroschewski.

On the 11th instant there will be due on the S.W.1/4, 9, \$118.40 principal and \$91.02 interest or a total of \$209.42.

On the N.W.1/4, 3, there will be due on the 11th instant, \$104.04 principal and \$83.88, totaling \$187.92.

On the N.E.1/4, 4, due same date, \$142.00 principal and \$114.49 interest, or a total of \$256.49.

And on the S.E.1/4, Sec. 4, the sum due is \$126.80 principal and \$80.84 interest, making a total of \$207.64.
