Circular.

Sir,

Relative to the Treaty payments, will you kindly add the following instructions to those already sent you, viz.:-

For the sake of greater accuracy in the payments, the names of Rebel Indians must be excluded from the regular Pay-sheets, but, for the sake of continuity, their number should be kept on the same Pay-lists as the loyal Indians, with the remark opposite each number in the column of names "Rebel Indians" in red ink. Fresh Pay-sheets showing the names and number in each family of Rebel Indians, and the amount that would have been payable to them, should be transmitted with the Pay-sheets of the Loyal Indians.
