SAILING REGULATIONS.

ARTICLE 1.

MANAGEMENT OF RACES.

SEC. 1. The arrangement for and management of all Races held under the suspices of the Association shall be in the hands of the Club holding the same.

SEC. 2. The Executive Committee may, however, at least one month prior to the first Race of the Annual Circuit, appoint an officer, at such remuneration as they may think fit, whose duty it shall be to attend all Regattas held under the anspices of the Association, and (under the direction of the officers of the Club giving the Regatta) superintend the laying and logging of courses and laying of buoys, calculate the time allowance in the different classes, see that the guns are fired at the proper times, and with the assistance of two properly qualified officers, who shall be appointed by the Club giving the Regatta, take the times of the competing skiffs at the finish, correct the same, and generally do such
