

PHILIPSBURG.

A small village in the parish of St. Armand West, County of Missisquoi, pleasantly situated on the shore of Missisquoi Bay. It has three churches, one hotel, two boarding-houses, elementary school, one wheelwright shop, one blacksmith shop, one store. Distance from St. Armand, 2 miles; Stanbridge Station, 6 miles; Bedford, 8 miles; Highgate Springs, Vt., 4 miles; Pike River Springs, 6 miles; by boat to Alburgh Springs, 8 miles. Population 150. Mails twice a day. Phillipsburg is an outport of St. Armand. Missisquoi Bay, which washes the shores of this village, is one of the most beautiful sheets of water that can be conceived, abounding in fish, while its marshes afford excellent shooting. Excellent variegated and black marble is found in its immediate vicinity. The village was incorporated in 1846, and is a popular summer resort.
