 4. The morbid anatomy of ulcerative endocarditis, cerebral hemorrhage, tubercular meningitis, and typhoid fever.
 5. The etiology, the diagnosis, and the special types of appendicitis.
 6. State what you know of auto-intoxication in disease.
 7. Discuss the antitoxin treatment of diphtheria, the indications for surgical interference in appendicitis, caffeine as a cardiac tonic, and outline the treatment in acute rheumatic endocarditis.
