- 5th. A road leading from Scott's Eridge on the river St. Charles, to the Road of Charlesbourge, although approved of by His Excellency, cannot be opened before next summer.
- 6th. A Bridge on St. Charles' River on the Road leading from the Concession of La pet to Rivière to Lorette Road, altho' approved by His Excellency, cannot be opened before next Summer.
- 7th. A Road of communication between the Townships of Frampton, Crambourne, and the first inhabitains of Ste. Marie and Jollief, altho' approved by His Excellency, could be opened only in part and will be completed next Summer.
- 8th. The south western landing place of the Ferry on the Cap Rouge River has been greatly improved:
- 9th. A Bridge on Ste. Aime River; altho approved of by His Excellency, can only be erected next Summer.
- 10th. And lastly a Road from the River Du Loup in the Parish of st. François, and leading towards Kennebeck River has been cut twelve feet wide on a length of 25 miles.

And in obedience to the dispositions of the latter part of the aforesaid recited 9th section, which directs that the Commissioners shall report all and every further observations and informations which they may think proper to convey concerning the improvements to be made in the internal communications of this Province, we humbly submit the following observations and informations distinguishing them in which the whole Province may be concerned and those of a more confined and local interest.

Amongst the former we humbly submit:

1st. That the bad state in which the moads within the Bunlioue of Quebec, are in general, seems to require the interference of the Legislature, to provide further means of putting the said roads in a better state.
