Date to be therein mentioned, be admitted into and become Part mit Rupert's of the Dominion of Canada; and thereupon it shall be lawful for Land into and the Parliament of Canada from the Date aforesaid to make, or-the Dominion dain, and establish within the Land and Territory so admitted as of Canada. aforesaid all such Laws, Institutions, and Ordinances, and to constitute such Courts and Officers, as may be necessary for the Peace, Order, and good Government of Her Majesty's Subjects and others therein: Provided that, until otherwise enacted by the said Parliament of Canada, all the Powers, Authorities, and Jurisdiction of tion of the several Courts of Justice now established in Rupert's present Courts Land, and of the several Officers thereof, and of all Magistrates and Officers and Justices now acting within the said Limits, shall continue in full force and effect therein.
