COUNTY AND DISTRICT.

Mr. Kennedy, who had completed his part of the work on a car, had taken a drink, and was talking to two companions engaged in adjusting the couplings to the almost completed car. Another box car almost completed was eight feet distant on the same track, and deceased's head was in a line with the couplers, when without the slightest notice the shunting engine struck the train of cars, sending the two together with great force. The couplers caught his head, smashing it to a jelly. Several other workmen narrowly escaped with their lives. Deceased leaves a wife and family.

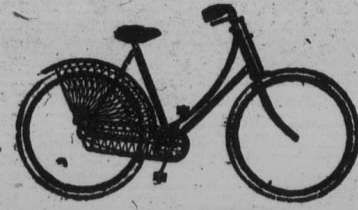
