FRENCH NAVAL PROGRAMMF. PARIS, April 24.

The French naval programme included in the 1925 Budget was voted to-day with only Communists oppos-ing, the vote being 422 to 29. The naval programme calls for laving the keels this year of one light cruiser, three destroyers, four torpedo boats, seven first class submarines, nine submarine mine layers, one surface nine layer, one aviation mother ship. The programme from 1925 to 1929 calls for laying the keels of 75 naval units at a cost of 3,194,000 francs. Only forty million francs will come out of the 1925 Budget. The four year programme, which contemplates construction, authorized France under the Washington Naval Agreement of 1922, calls for four battle cruisers, fifteen destroyers, eighteen torpedo boats, two submarine cruisers, conseight first class submarines and sub-




