## WILL HELP NEEDY

Propose To Have Christmas Cheer Pops On Streets Saturday.

ST. THOMAS, Dec. 12.—So that the needy families of this city will not go without cheer this Christmas, the St. Thomas branch of the I. O. D. E. will place Christmas pops on the street corners Saturday, to give the general public an opportunity to make contributions. The pops will be under the supervision of the Horticultural Society of the Salvation Army and the G. W. V. A.

In addition to this the I. O. D. E. will make a tour of all the shops Saturday in an endeavor to boost the fund to the desired \$5,000.

Successful efforts to secure the co-operation of practically every organization in the city in spreading the Christmas cheer was made at a large meeting of the society Monday night in the city hall. Assurance of co-operation was received from more than 30 organizations, while others are expected to fall in with the plan within the next few days.

The Elks of this city are collecting a separate fund, but the two organizations are working so that there will be no overlapping in the distribution of baskets.
