HOUSE BURNED.—The house owned and occupied by Capt. George Gower, at Centreville, was totally destroyed by fire yesterday morning. The flames were discovered about eleven o'clock, and as soon as alarm was given, neighbors hastened to the premises and assisted in saving most of the furniture, though some in the upper portion of the building could not be obtained. The house and property was formerly owned by Mr. Manley Benson, and was purchased by Captain Gower about a year ago. To Y. M. C. association (for the purpose of making their library and premises attractive to young men), \$10,000.
To the town of Dartmouth, towards the services of a superior teacher for the public schools, \$5,000.
To Dalhousie college \$10,000, so long as it shall remain a non-sectarian institution.
Any residue from the above bequests is to be divided as follows: One-third to the Dartmouth public schools, one-third to Dalhousie college, and one-third to the above named religious and charitable institutions.
