notwithstanding the severity of the weather, cheerfully gave their services for this purpose. They were impressed by the numbers, intelligence, and general prosperity of the members of the Church of England, in this part of the diocese; and are convinced that more than one of the missions visited might, with great advantage, be divided, and that in the event of division a largely increased liberality would be drawn forth.
