- The following criteria shall be taken into account in considering whether a precursor to a Schedule I chemical would be included in Schedule 2 part A:
- (a) It may be used in one of the chemical reactions at the final stage of formation of a chemical listed in Scheidle 1.
- (b) If may pase a significant risk to the objectives of the Convention by virtue of its importance in the production of a chemical listed in Schedule 1.
- (c) It is not produced in large commercial quantities for purposes not prohibited under dist convention.
