

In the course of the negotiations leading to this agreement, the Government of the United States has assured the Canadian Government that in its view the treaty will be expeditiously advised and consented to by the U.S. Senate.

Provisions relating to the enforcement and to the interpretation and application of the treaty are also included.

The agreement was signed today in Washington, for the U.S.A., by Deputy Secretary of State William P. Clark and, for Canada, by the Ambassador to the U.S.A., Peter M. Towe.
