PRAYERS.

Mr. Speaker laid before the House,—Report of the Chief Electoral Officer in conformity with Section 58 of the Dominion Elections Act, 1938—General Election of June 27, 1949.

Mr. Adamson, seconded by Mr. Tustin, by leave of the House, introduced a Bill, No. 6, An Act to amend the Navigable Waters' Protection Act, which was read the first time, and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

Mr. Adamson, seconded by Mr. Tustin, by leave of the House, introduced a Bill, No. 7, An Act to amend the Railway Act, which was read the first time, and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The following Bill from the Senate, viz:—Bill No. 4 (Letter D of the Senate), intituled: "An Act to amend the Criminal Code", (*Mr. Garson*), was read the first time.

By leave of the House, the said Bill was read the second time, considered in Committee of the Whole, reported with an amendment, considered as amended, read the third time and passed.

The House then resumed the adjourned Debate on the proposed motion of Mr. Garson: That Bill No. 2, An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, be now read the second time, and on the proposed amendment thereto of Mr. Drew.

And the Debate continuing;
