On motion of Sir Leonard Tilley, The House went into Committee, to consider a certain proposed Resolution, to extend the Act establishing one uniform Currency for the Dominion of Canada, to the Provinces of British Columbia and Prince Edward Island.

(In the Committee.)

The following Resolution was adopted: -

Resolved, That it is expelient to extend the Act 34 Victoria, Chapter 4, establishing one uniform Currency for the Dominion of Canada, to the Provinces of British Columbia and Prince Edward Island.

Resolution to be reported.

The said Resolution was accordingly reported, read a second time, and agreed to.

Sir Leonard Tilley then introduced a Bill No. 66 to extend the Act establishing one uniform Currency for the Dominion of Canada, to the Provinces of British Columbia and Prince Edward Island; which was read the first time, and ordered for a second reading, to-morrow.

On motion of Sir Leonard Tilley it was Resolved, That the Government business shall have precedence on Thursday, during the remainder of the Session.

The House then adjourned.
